Staff receive ongoing training in areas such as First Aid, CPR, medication assistance, crisis prevention, seizure response, communicable diseases, and more. Staff-to-participant ratios are carefully maintained to ensure quality care, supervision, and safety. Best of all, there are no fees charged for our services.

SOME OF OUR PROGRAMS

JOBS (JOB OPPORTUNITY BUILDERS

This program concentrates on helping you get the skills you need to work at a job in the community. We can help you find job openings, prepare resumes, and set up interviews. Our supported

Employment program is designated for those who may need a little extra support. We will continue to work with you as long as you might need or want our support. In some cases we can even provide a coach to help you learn the new job

MEDICAID WAIVER PROGRAMS

We are licensed providers of Day Training (DT) services and Supported Employment services

under the Supports for Community Living Waiver (SCL) and the Michelle P Waiver (MPW). These are programs provided through Kentucky Medicaid.

WORK SERVICES

We do work for several companies in our area. Jobs might include assembling small parts, packaging, recycling, etc. You do get paid for the work that you do in our program!



NON-WORK SERVICES

Our program is about more than work — it's about building confidence, independence, friendships, and life skills while having fun along the way. Participants can choose from a wide variety of

engaging classes, activities, volunteer opportunities, and community outings designed to encourage personal growth and self-enrichment.

Whether learning practical skills like budgeting, communication, nutrition, grooming, and independent living, or participating in educational classes and hands-on activities, each person is encouraged to explore new interests and abilities in a supportive environment.

Community involvement is an important part of our program. Volunteer opportunities and local outings allow participants to connect with others, enjoy new experiences, and take part in community events. Special trips may include movies, museums, sporting events, theater performances, lunches with friends, and other exciting adventures.

Participants also enjoy regular activities at the Center, including arts and crafts, exercise classes, games, social activities, and creative projects. Best of all, individuals have a voice in planning their own schedule — choosing activities and experiences that match their interests and goals, just like ordering from a menu.
